### **Covid Testing:**

With the rising cases of Covid-19 currently in circulation in the area, we just wanted to give some advice about testing. Some parents are testing children who are displaying symptoms using a Lateral Flow Tests (the ones which are widely available from pharmacies etc). These are designed for regular testing of people who are currently displaying no symptoms. If they produce a positive result, a PCR test is still needed to confirm a positive case of Covid-19. The LFT tests are not designed to be used instead of the PCR tests.

If someone is displaying symptoms of Covid-19, then a PCR test (bookable online to have one done at The Beehive or posted out to your home) is the one that is required to confirm a positive or negative diagnosis of Covid-19.

If children are sent home from school with possible symptom of Covid-19, the production of a negative Lateral flow Test is not sufficient for the child to return to school. You are required to self isolate for 10 days or return a negative result of a PCR test.

## Parent Support Advisor Contact:


