



Just for Fun - Game of the Week:

Each week, we thought we might suggest a fun game or activity you can play at home with your child. These might have a theme; such as wellbeing, listening or thinking skills, or working memory but they are certainly intended to be something fun you can do together at home. Enjoy!

This week's game promotes good focus and concentration. It is called Mirror, Mirror! Stand face to face with your child, fairly close together. Lead some actions such as hands on your head, standing on one leg etc. Your child has to mirror you and match your actions exactly as a mirror image. Begin the movements slowly, then speed up once children are more confident. Swap over so that your child has a change to lead the actions and you have to be the mirror. You could do really small or really large scale movements.
