Points for Improvement:

- Introduce selves on the home visit.
- Ensure children's name spelt correctly on the information pack.
- Full time after a couple of half days
- Uniform list and requirements was lacking
- A note home about how the teacher deals with discipline issues at school would help so we know in advance and can work with similar expectations at home
- Afternoon sessions not beneficial as so short compared to the mornings.
- Shame that hedgehogs are dropped off and picked up in year 1 playground would be nice for the newbies to all be together.
- It would be helpful to have the settling in arrangements in the prospectus so that parents can keep sufficient annual leave
- Perhaps a photograph tour could be available to talk through and show the children and talk to them ahead of their first day.
- Home visit could be a little longer
- It is hard for the little ones to go in by themselves when they have to battle past other parents at the coat hooks. Could all parents say goodbye at the bottom of the steps?
- Would like info on when forest school and PE would start
- Information on general school timetable would be useful start and finish times.
- Perhaps bringing your child to school for a one to one visit would be better than a home visit?
- The information evening felt a little too informal.
- Perhaps include a Q&A session for new parents a smaller group atmosphere
- I would have liked some information about the kinds of activities the children do during the day.
- A nursery visit would have been beneficial.
